

SUBJECT: The Ohio-Kentucky-Indiana Regional Council of Governments (OKI) update on the 2030 Regional Transportation Plan.

PURPOSE:

To provide information to the Cincinnati City Planning Commission on the updates to the 2030 Regional Transportation Plan, which is scheduled to be adopted in June 2008 and submitted to the federal highway and federal transit administrations for their review and approval.

DISCUSSION:

Every four years, the Ohio-Indiana-Kentucky Regional Council of Governments (OKI) updates the OKI 2030 Regional Transportation Plan. The Plan is the long-range, comprehensive transportation-planning document for the three-state, eight-county Greater Cincinnati region. It defines the overarching goals for transportation in our region, establishes existing and future transportation needs of the region and allocates projected revenue to transportation programs and projects that address those needs.

OKI began working on the 2030 Regional Transportation Plan Update in March 2007. Work continues to identify priority projects to be included in the Plan. OKI is scheduled to adopt the Plan Update in June 2008. Upon adoption, the Plan will be submitted to the federal highway and federal transit administrations for their review and approval.

Projects using federal funding are required to be included in the OKI Regional Transportation Plan. The OKI web site provides additional information about activities undertaken or planned by OKI as part of this process. <http://www.oki.org/transportation/2030update08.html>
