2009 Street Rehabilitation – Hyde Park

As part of the City's investment in the neighborhood of Hyde Park, the City of Cincinnati has contracted with Barrett Paving and Materials to rehabilitate the following Streets.

1. Berry Avenue from Observatory Avenue to Erie Avenue
2. Dana Avenue from Madison Road to Floral Avenue
3. Erie Avenue from Zumstein Avenue to Madison Road
4. Observatory Avenue from Edwards Road to Madison Road
5. Stettinius Avenue from Observatory Avenue to Madison Road
6. Madison Road from Dana Avenue to O'Bryon Street

This project includes the construction of new asphalt pavement, handicap ramps and curb repair.

The project will start in August of this year and is anticipated to be completed by July of 2010.

Motorists are encouraged to help improve safety by reducing their speed and using caution when approaching the construction area. Traffic delays are possible and motorists may wish to seek alternate routes.

This project is funded jointly by the City of Cincinnati and the Ohio Public Works Commission.
