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**MSD Notice of Construction  
420-426 Three Rivers Parkway Local Assessment Sewer  
In the Village of North Bend, Hamilton County, Ohio**

Cincinnati, March 20, 2009. The Board of County Commissioners has recently approved funding for the 420-426 Three Rivers Parkway Local Assessment Sewer. Managed by the Metropolitan Sewer District of Greater Cincinnati (MSD), construction is scheduled to begin April 2009 and is scheduled to be completed in August 2009. The construction contract amount is \$69,592 and was awarded to Ken Neyer Plumbing.

The project consists of the installation of 588 feet of 3-inch diameter sanitary sewer, 5 low pressure force main sewer laterals, 2 flushing chambers, and other sewer appurtenances. The project begins at an existing manhole in the intersection of Shady Lane and Three Rivers Parkway, then proceeds east, terminating at House Number 426 Three Rivers Parkway. The project is an assessment sewer that will eliminate the need for onsite sewage treatment systems at 3 existing residences and 2 businesses. The project is located in the Village of North Bend.

Every day, the Metropolitan Sewer District of Greater Cincinnati (MSD) manages the effective collection and treatment of more than 200 million gallons of wastewater and actively maintains 3,000 miles of sanitary and combined sewers that run through 49 municipalities and townships of Hamilton County. Owned by Hamilton County and operated by the City of Cincinnati, MSD is committed to continually maintaining and improving its wastewater collection and treatment systems for the betterment of both public and environmental health.

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
