Bengals Game Day Traffic Notes

As another exciting season of Cincinnati Bengals football begins, construction continues in the area around Paul Brown Stadium on The Banks project. In order to minimize confusion while going to or coming from the games, the following road closures should be noted:

Pregame- These roads will close 3-4 hours before a game and, unless listed on the Postgame list, will be reopened when the game begins:

- Northbound Central Avenue- closed between Mehring Way and W Pete Rose Way
- Elm Street- closed between Second Street and Ted Berry Way
- Eastbound Ted Berry Way- closed between Elm Street and Rosa Parks Street

Postgame- Roads are closed after the game to accommodate traffic leaving the parking lots. These roads will close around the fourth quarter and remain closed until traffic has cleared the area:

- Central Avenue- closed between W Pete Rose Way and Mehring Way
- Southbound Central Avenue- closed between Seventh Street and Fourth Street
- Elm Street- closed between Second Street and Ted Berry Way
- Northbound Elm Street- closed between Mehring Way and Ted Berry Way
- Westbound Ted Berry Way- closed between Rosa Parks Street and Elm Street
- Southbound Joe Nuxhall Way (Main St)- closed between Second St and Mehring Way
- Westbound Mehring Way-closed between E Pete Rose Way and Joe Nuxhall Way
- Southbound Gest Street- closed between Linn Street and Mehring Way
- Eastbound Third Street- closed between Clay Wade Bailey Bridge and Central Avenue
- Fourth Street- closed between Elm Street and Plum Street
- Westbound E. Pete Rose Way- closed between Broadway and Old Broadway
- Eastbound W. Pete Rose Way- closed between Gest Street and Central Avenue
- Southbound Old Broadway- closed between E.Pete Rose Way and Mehring Way
- NO LEFT TURN from Third Street or Sixth Street to southbound Central Avenue
