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### Central Avenue Improvements

**WHAT/WHEN:** As part of the City of Cincinnati's improvements downtown, the **Central Avenue Improvement Project** will begin **Monday, January 30, 2006**. The contractor, Prus Construction Company, will reconstruct curb and sidewalks on both sides of Central Avenue from Third Street to Seventh Street. The company will also install new light poles, fixtures, traffic signals, parking meters, signage, and trees, and resurface all the pavement within the work limits. The project should end by October 2006.

**TRAFFIC NOTES:** From 7 A.M. to 9 A.M. and from 4 P.M. to 6 P.M. Monday through Friday, two hours prior and after all major downtown events, and during non-working hours, the contractor will keep two northbound lanes and two southbound lanes open and available for traffic. During working hours, he will keep one northbound lane and one southbound lane open. The contractor will limit on-street parking on Central Avenue for the duration of this project.

The Department of Transportation and Engineering oversees the rehabilitation and improvement of streets in the City of Cincinnati. The Department is also provides transportation planning, design, engineering services, structural and geotechnical services, right of way regulation, and construction management. It is the clearinghouse for all City and regional transportation functions, and serves as a liaison to the Southwest Ohio Regional Transit Authority.
