**MSD Notice of Construction Completion
Glenwood Avenue Sewer Repair
In the City of Cincinnati, Hamilton County, Ohio**

Cincinnati, November 19, 2008. The construction of the Glenwood Avenue Sewer Repair project was substantially completed September 25, 2008, by Sunesis Construction.

This project consisted of the installation of approximately 680 feet of 24-inch combined sewer and appurtenances, and the abandonment of approximately 180 feet of badly deteriorated existing sewer. The project is located on Glenwood Avenue between Reading Road and Glenwood Place, and at Burton School in the North Avondale neighborhood of the City of Cincinnati.

This project is part of MSD's ongoing Capital Improvement Program (CIP), which is focused on continually updating and improving the operation of MSD's wastewater collection and treatment systems.

Every day, the Metropolitan Sewer District of Greater Cincinnati (MSD) manages the effective collection and treatment of more than 200 million gallons of wastewater and actively maintains 3,000 miles of sanitary and combined sewers that run through 49 municipalities and townships of Hamilton County. Owned by Hamilton County and operated by the City of Cincinnati, MSD is committed to continually maintaining and improving its wastewater collection and treatment systems for the betterment of both public and environmental health.
