ROAD CLOSURE

HIGHLAND AVENUE, NORTH BOUND

FROM McMILLAN STREET EAST TO WM. H. TAFT ROAD

LANE REDUCTION

AND POSSIBLE DELAYS

ON EASTBOUND McMILLAN STREET EAST

WEST OF HIGHLAND AVENUE

Beginning at 7:00 AM on Saturday, March 18, 2006, and continuing until approximately 9:00 PM the same day, Highland Avenue, northbound only, will be closed to vehicular and pedestrian traffic through the work area between McMillan Street and William Howard Taft Road. The Highland Avenue detour will be east on McMillan Street, to left on May Street, to left on Wm. H. Taft Road, back to Highland Avenue. A signed detour will be provided by the Contractor. Local access around the work area will be maintained.

In addition, eastbound McMillan Street will be temporarily reduced to a single lane through the signal at Highland Avenue. A Police Officer will be on site to assist traffic as necessary. Any traffic using this route could experience delays, and are encouraged to use an alternate route.

This closure and lane reductions is to allow the safe demolition of the adjacent building. The work will be done by Evans Landscape for Kauffman/Jacobs JFP Group. Bus service will be directed around the closed area. Riders should use the next nearest stop.

Motorists are encouraged to use caution and reduce their speed when approaching the work area.
