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## MSD Notice of Construction Completion

### **HENGEHOLD 4<sup>th</sup> and YATES 3<sup>rd</sup> PUMP STATION ELIMINATIONS In Green Township and the City of Cheviot, Hamilton County, Ohio**

Cincinnati, November 4, 2008. The construction of the Hengehold 4<sup>th</sup> and Yates 3<sup>rd</sup> Pump Station Elimination project was substantially completed October 22, 2008, by Rack and Ballauer Excavating Company.

This project consisted of the elimination of the Hengehold 4<sup>th</sup> and Yates 3<sup>rd</sup> Pump Stations by installing approximately 2,760 feet of 12-inch sanitary sewer and appurtenances, 195 feet of which was installed by the jack-and-bore method. The project was located within property bounded by Reemelin Road to the north, School Section Road to the west, Simca Lane and Westwood Northern Boulevard to the south, and Washington Avenue to the east in Green Township and the City of Cheviot.

This project is part of MSD's ongoing Capital Improvement Program (CIP), which is focused on continually updating and improving the operation of MSD's wastewater collection and treatment systems.

Every day, the Metropolitan Sewer District of Greater Cincinnati (MSD) manages the effective collection and treatment of more than 200 million gallons of wastewater and actively maintains 3,000 miles of sanitary and combined sewers that run through the 49 municipalities and townships of Hamilton County. Owned by Hamilton County and operated by the City of Cincinnati, MSD is committed to continually maintaining and improving its wastewater collection and treatment systems for the betterment of both public and environmental health.

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
