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## Upcoming Construction

### Madison Road Improvements

- The City of Cincinnati and the Ohio Public Works Commission have invested \$5,760,000 into public improvements in the Oakley Community on Madison Road between Ridge Avenue and Allston Street. The total investment combines \$4,225,000 from Cincinnati Water Works to install new water mains and \$1,535,000 from City capital funds, in conjunction with an Ohio Public Works Commission grant, to implement infrastructure improvements in the Oakley Business District.
- The project improves the geometrics of the intersection of Madison Road and Ridge Avenue to allow all vehicular turning movements to maneuver safely and decrease accidents. This improvement is in coordination with the Kennedy Connector proposed plan.
- In addition, a streetscape will be constructed in the Oakley Business District that includes sidewalk and curb replacements, new asphalt pavement, new street trees, installing decorative signs and meter posts along with pedestrian level lighting. Improvements will also be made under the railroad overpass on Madison Road that includes the sidewalks, walls, and steps.
- The City has contracted with Adleta Construction to perform the improvements, and construction is anticipated to begin in February and to be completed by November of this year.

**Madison Road will have one lane in each direction open and available to traffic at all times. Drivers are encouraged to reduce their speed and use caution when approaching the construction area.**

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
