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Mt. Auburn Street Rehabilitation

As part of the City of Cincinnati's ongoing investment in the neighborhoods of Mt. Auburn, Walnut Hills and Corryville, the Department of Transportation and Engineering will soon begin street rehabilitation work on the following streets: Auburn Ave., Burnet Ave., McMillan St., Vine St. and Wm. H. Taft Rd.

The City's contractor, Little Miami Construction Company, will perform the following work: grinding off the existing asphalt; performing partial- and full-depth repairs; placing an intermediate course of asphalt; replacing deteriorated curbs; constructing curb ramps, sidewalks and driveway aprons where necessary; performing inlet repairs and adjustments; adjusting utility castings to grade; and resurfacing the entire pavement.

The following traffic restrictions apply:

- From 6 AM to 9 AM and from 3 PM to 6 PM, all lanes, with the exception of unrestricted parking lanes, will be open and available to traffic.
- During all other working hours, at least two lanes will be open and available to traffic; two lanes on one-way streets, and one lane in each direction on two-way streets.
- In general, during all non-working hours, the streets shall be open and available for the movement of traffic.
- Access for emergency vehicles, businesses and residents shall be maintained at all times.

Drivers are encouraged to reduce their speed and use caution when approaching the closure area.
