Streetscape Improvements for Mt. Lookout Square

As part of the City of Cincinnati's investment in the neighborhood of Mt. Lookout, crews from R A Miller Construction will be installing new curbs, sidewalks, brick pavers, and streetlights and replacing trees in the south half of Mt. Lookout Square. In addition crews will rebuild the traffic signals at the south intersection of Linwood and Delta and the mid-block crosswalk at the parking island and install electrical outlets in the parking island.

This is Phase I of a multi-phased approach to enhance the Mt. Lookout business district. The timing of future phases is dependent on funding availability.

This project will begin on June 7, 2010 and will be completed in October, 2010.

Traffic restrictions will be as follows:

- 1) Delta and Linwood Avenues - During all times one 11 foot wide lane must be open in each direction.
- 2) Alpine Terrace - All lanes must be open during non-working hours. During all other times one 10 foot wide lane must be open.
- 3) Pedestrian access will be maintained to all businesses during construction.
