STREET CLOSURES FOR OKTOBERFEST 2006

The annual "Oktoberfest Zinzinnati" event will be held on September 16th and 17th this year. There is also a Cincinnati Bengals football game at Paul Brown Stadium which begins at 1:00 PM on Sunday, September 17, 2006. Those that attend these events will need to be aware of the following traffic restrictions.

Beginning at 6:00 P.M. Friday, September 15, 2006 and continuing until 5:00 A.M. Monday, September 18, 2006, the following streets will be closed to all traffic due to the 2006 Oktoberfest celebration:

- 1) Fifth Street between Race Street and Broadway Street.
- 2) Vine Street between Fourth and Sixth Streets with access provided to parking garages.
- 3) Walnut Street between Fourth and Sixth Streets with access provided to parking garages.
- 4) Main Street between Fourth and Sixth Streets with access provided to parking garages.
- 5) Sycamore Street between Fourth and Sixth Streets with access provided to parking garages.

The following streets will be changed from one-way to two way operation to provide access to abutting properties.

- 1) Vine Street between Fourth and Fifth Streets.
- 2) Broadway between Sixth and Fifth Streets.

All parking on the above mentioned streets will be prohibited. Parking will also be prohibited on both sides of Sixth Street from Broadway to Vine and on the south side of Sixth Street from Vine to Elm Streets.

Metro bus services will be routed around the closed areas and motorists are urged to use alternate routes.
