The Cincinnati Park Board is now hiring for Season Maintenance Workers for 2009. Must be a resident of Hamilton County, at least 18 years of age, have a valid Ohio driver's license, have a good police record and be able to pass a drug screen. Hourly rate: \$8.50, up to 40 hours per week during the season. Able to perform heavy to very heavy physical labor.

Seasonal Maintenance Workers perform grounds maintenance including mowing, hand-trimming bushes, clearing weeds, litter pick-up and trash collection; manual landscaping tasks such as installing trail ties, loading/unloading fertilizer and mulch; park building maintenance and cleaning—sweeping and mopping floors.
