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2009 Street Rehabilitation – CIP East

As part of the City's investment in the neighborhood of Columbia Tusculum, Hyde Park, Roselawn, Mt. Lookout, Walnut Hills, Mt. Washington, and Linwood, the City of Cincinnati has contracted with Adleta Construction Company to rehabilitate the following Streets.

1. Aylesboro Ave from East Term to Wilshire Avenue
2. Bevis Ave from Hewitt Ave to Dana Avenue
3. Brentwood Ave from Erie Ave to Saybrook Ave
4. Burch Ave from Madison Rd to North Term
5. Clarion Ave from Evanston Ave to Dana Ave
6. Craigland Ct from East Term to West Term
7. Craigland Ln from Craigland Ct to Glade Ave
8. Crestwood Ave from Principio Ave to Aultwoods Ln
9. Dillon Ave from Principio Ave to North Term
10. Evanston Ave from South Term Ave to Clarion Ave
11. Far Hills Dr from Michigan Ave to Green Hills Ave
12. Francis Ln from Victory Parkway to Park Ave
13. Hokel Ln from Redfield Pl to Keystone Dr
14. Hurley Ave from Kenova Ave to Robinwood Ave
15. Isis Ave from South Term to Griest Ave
16. Kenlee Dr from Coffey St to Silverfox Dr
17. Keystone Dr from South term to North Term
18. Lusanne Ter from Mayland Dr to West Term
19. Mannington Ave from Tweed Ave to Van Dyke Ave
20. Michigan Ave from Far Hills Dr to Observatory Ave
21. Parkdale Ave from Hurley Ave to Section Rd
22. Perkins Ln from Edwards Rd to Stettinius Ave
23. Redfield Pl from Beechmont Ave to North Term
24. Rosecliff Ave from Reading Rd to Parkdale Ave
25. Scottwood Ave from Kenova Ave to Shenandoah Ave
26. Summit Rd from Reinhold Dr to Corp Line
27. Tusculum Ave from Vineyard Pl to Grandin Rd
28. Wilshire Ave from Ault Park Ave to Saybrook Ave
29. Zan Ct from South Term to Linwood Ave

This project includes the construction of new asphalt pavement, handicap ramps and curb repair.

The project will commence on June 1, 2009 and is anticipated to be completed by September of this year.

Motorists are encouraged to help improve safety by reducing their speed and using caution when approaching the construction area. Traffic delays are possible and motorists may wish to seek alternate routes.
