Road Improvement – Winton Road and Gray Road

As part of the City of Cincinnati's ongoing investment in the neighborhood of Spring Grove Village, the Department of Transportation and Engineering will soon begin street improvement work on the intersection of Gray Road and Winton Road. Construction will begin on August 23, 2010. The work will include widening of lanes, left turn lanes from Gray Road to Winton, new concrete curbs, sidewalks, curb ramps and new traffic signal equipment. There will also include street rehabilitation on Winton from Gray Road to Spring Grove Avenue. Prus Construction Company is the contractor responsible for the reconstruction work.

The contractor will maintain traffic on the project streets. However, traffic will be restricted as follows during various phases of construction:

- On Winton Road from the hours of 6AM to 9AM and from 3PM to 6PM, Monday through Friday, all lanes will be open and available to traffic. All other times at least two 11' lanes will be open and available to traffic (one lane in each direction). All lanes not approved for permanent closure will be open and available to traffic when no work is being done.
- On Gray Road traffic will be maintained at all times. At least two 10' lanes will remain open and available to traffic (one lane in each direction) at all times, or a flagger will be used to move traffic through and around the work areas. A police officer will get used if through traffic gets affected in any way.

Drivers are encouraged to reduce their speed and use caution when approaching the closure area.
