SHULLER'S WIGWAM DEMOLITION BEGINS JUNE 20, 2006

WHAT/WHEN: As part of the City of Cincinnati's program to redevelop vacant sites in College Hill at the intersection of Hamilton Avenue and North Bend Road, demolition of the building previously occupied by the Shuller's Wigwam Restaurant begins Tuesday, June 20, 2006. **All Ways Trucking and Excavating**, will remove the abandoned structure located at 6120 Hamilton Avenue. The contractor will fill all voids left from the removals to the existing ground level, and should complete the work by August 2006. Under the agreement between the City and the developer, Al Neyer, Inc., the mixed-use redevelopment of the site will include new residential condominiums and leasable retail and office space.

The Department of Transportation and Engineering oversees the rehabilitation and improvement of streets in the City of Cincinnati. The Department is also provides transportation planning, design, engineering services, structural and geotechnical services, right of way regulation, and construction management. It is the clearinghouse for all City and regional transportation functions, and serves as a liaison to the Southwest Ohio Regional Transit Authority.
