## GLENVIEW AVENUE IMPROVEMENTS AND ROADWAY CLOSURE

**WHAT/WHEN:** Stabilizing the adjacent hillsides and rehabilitating the roadway and drainage system are part of the City's improvement plans for Glenview Avenue.

The street rehabilitation work includes removing the existing asphalt surface and replacing it with new asphalt, repairing deteriorated curbs, constructing sidewalks, driveway aprons and curb ramps, removing old guardrails and installing new ones, along with installing new pavement markings.

In order to perform the work safely and efficiently, Glenview Avenue from Kirby Road to Tanglewood Lane will be closed to all traffic beginning January 15, 2006 for approximately 105 days. Local residents will have access from Belmont Avenue. Detours signs will be posted using Hamilton Avenue and Ashtree Drive.

This work may cause some delays to travelers, so motorists may wish to seek alternate routes to their destinations.
