CITY OF CINCINNATI SNOW OPERATIONS UPDATE

OPERATIONS STATUS: The National Weather Services has issued a Hazardous Weather Outlook Forecast with light snow accumulations possible Monday night and early Tuesday morning as a quick moving disturbance moves across the area.

City crews have been pre-treating all major streets with salt brine in anticipation of any snow showers. City crews will continue to monitor forecasts and road conditions overnight. All crews will be called in if weather conditions warrant full winter operations.

City crews will continue working throughout the night Monday and early morning Tuesday to make roads safe for travel. Citizens should allow plenty of driving time and use extreme caution when driving.

WINTER OPERATIONS FACTS & FIGURES:

The 2006 - 2007 Winter Operations Program is focused on:

- * Safety for travelers
- * A goal of having streets treated and safe for travel within 24 hours of the end of an ordinary snowfall.
- * Working with area's travelers and top employers to help clear roads of rush hour traffic during major snowstorms

All four salt domes are filled to capacity with contracts in place for salt purchases throughout the winter, if needed.

City's fleet of pick-up trucks and dump trucks has been inspected.

All plows and salt spreaders have been tested in preparation for the coming winter.
