Walnut Hills, Wyoming high schools make Newsweek's Top 100 ranking

Two Greater Cincinnati high schools, **Walnut Hills High School** and **Wyoming High School**, are in the top 100 of Newsweek's best-performing U.S. high schools according to the magazine's May 25 issue.

Walnut Hills ranked at 56, down from 36 in 2007. Wyoming made the top 100 for the first time, debuting at 87.

Indian Hill High School, which ranked 84th last year, didn't make the top 100 in 2008. It ranked at 120.

The news magazine ranked 1,300 public high schools, which it deemed to be the top 5 percent in the country for the number of students they prepare for college. It determined the ranking by dividing the number of Advanced Placement, International Baccalaureate and/or Cambridge tests taken by all students at a school in 2007 by the number of graduating seniors.

Walnut Hills is part of **Cincinnati Public Schools**, and Wyoming is part of the **Wyoming City School District**.
