Miami makes BusinessWeek's best business schools lists

The Farmer School of Business at **Miami University** improved its ranking to 24th in BusinessWeek's 2008 "Top Undergraduate Business Programs" list.

The school, with more than 2,000 students, ranked 35th on the 2007 list. This year, it ranked 44th in the student survey conducted by the magazine and 10th in the recruiter survey. It received As for teaching quality and job placement, and a B for facilities and service.

Measures of academic quality, starting salaries for graduates, and the programs' performance as a "feeder" for MBA students were also among the criteria used for the rankings.

Other regional schools on the list included **Indiana University** (16th), Case Western Reserve University (41st), Ohio State University (59th), the **University of Kentucky** (87th) and the **University of Louisville** (92nd).
