KZF Design moving downtown

KZF Design Inc. is moving its headquarters downtown as part of a \$6 million expansion, the company announced today.

The Walnut Hills-based architecture and planning firm has purchased a three-story building at 700 Broadway. The firm plans to renovate the 36,000 square foot building into a "show place for sustainable design," said William H. Wilson III, the company's president and CEO.

KZF expects the building, once finished, will achieve silver certification under the Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design program. The building rating system, which measures energy efficiency and environmental impacts, was created by the U.S. Green Building Council.

The firm's move from its current offices at the Baldwin Center on Eden Park Drive into its new headquarters is slated for summer of 2009, the company said.

KZF has more than 110 employees at its headquarters. The firm also has offices in Atlanta, Orlando and Tampa.
