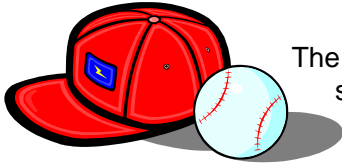

2009 ADULT FALL SOFTBALL REGISTRATION



The Cincinnati Recreation Commission begins registration for the 2009 Fall Softball season on **Monday, July 13, 2009**. **League play begins Sunday, August 16, 2009** or as soon as summer leagues are completed.

Priority Registration – for teams who played in **fall 2008** – will take place from **Monday, July 13, 2009** to **Wednesday, July 22, 2009**.

Open Registration for all new teams and those who may have missed priority will start on **Thursday, July 23, 2009**, and continue until leagues fill.

Leagues are being offered for Co-Rec and Men's teams and will be played at Schmidt and Salway fields. All fields are lighted. The league fee for an **8** game lighted league is **\$350.00**. The league fee for an **8** game unlighted league (*Sunday afternoon*) is **\$285.00**. This amount is due at the time of registration.

Applications and payment will be accepted at the CRC Athletic Office Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. until 4:30 p.m. Payment may be made with cash (in person only), check, money order or Visa/MasterCard. Credit card payments for applications that are faxed in (352-1605) or submitted on our web site at www.cincyrec.org. (the preferred method of registration) require that YOU phone the Athletics Division with the credit card number and expiration date to complete the registration process (after submitting).

Teams withdrawing prior to completion of league schedules will be assessed a \$25.00 service charge for clerical and material fees. Teams withdrawing after completion of schedules will be assessed \$50.00 plus prorated game fee. Teams withdrawing after the second game will receive no refund.

New teams will need to pick up the managers packet at the CRC Athletic office prior to the start of the season.

Rosters are due in the Athletics office before the first played game. Rosters and CRC rulebook are available on the web site.
