

# City Issues and Community Concerns

## City Issues

- High crash issue on West MLK Drive between West McMicken Avenue and Dixmyth Avenue
- Capacity issues at West MLK Drive and Dixmyth Avenue
- High crash and pedestrian issues at West MLK Drive and Clifton Avenue
- Accessibility of other transportation modes throughout the West MLK Drive corridor
- Coordinate with ODOT on the I-75 Millcreek Expressway project

## Community Concerns

- Visibility concerns in the curvy (tight turn) part of West MLK Drive
- Improve pedestrian, bicycle, and transit access
- Reduce crash rate
- Too much speeding downhill on West MLK Drive
- Reduce congestion
- Add a center lane to improve left-turn ability into driveways between West McMicken Ave and Dixmyth Avenue
- Improve access in and out of Riddle Road
- Existing lanes along West MLK Drive are too narrow
- Reduce cut through traffic on residential streets
- Remove on-street parking
- Provide a full-time parking lane or off-street parking
