MARCH 2007 STATS

MARCH COMPLAINTS

During the month of March 2007, LUK received 27 contacts (phone calls, e-mails or walk-ins) from 6 individuals lodging 27 complaints. One of the complaints was general and 26 were time-specific. Specific complaints reported included the following types of operations:

- 4 jets
- 7 props
- 5 helicopters
- 7 unidentified aircraft
- 3 run-ups

Reported disturbances (15) that were observed between the hours of 11 PM and 7 AM, at which time the tower is closed and voluntary restrictions are in effect, accounted for 58% of the aircraft disturbance complaints.

The complaints regarding run-ups resulted in an increase of calls received in March 2007 (27 contacts/ 27 complaints) compared to March 2006 (14 contacts/ 14 complaints). Staff reviewed, and updated the LUK 2002 Run-up Policy and distributed to all airport operators.

MARCH OPERATIONS

LUK operations increased 9% in March 2007 (5,801 ops.) compared with March 2006 (5,299 ops.). Source of LUK operations information: Lunken Airport Air Traffic Control Tower reports.

LUK IFR operations increased 4% in March 2007 (4,715 IFR ops.) compared with March 2006 (4,540 IFR ops). In March 2007 IFR ops represented 59% of the total operations vs. 66% in 2006. Source of LUK operations information: Greater Cincinnati-Northern Kentucky International Airport (CVG) Air Traffic Control Tower reports.

APRIL 2007 STATS

APRIL COMPLAINTS

During the month of April 2007, LUK received 15 contacts (phone calls, e-mails or walk-ins) from 9 individuals lodging, 15 complaints. Specific complaints reported include the following types of operations:

- 2 jets
- 2 props
- 4 helicopters
- 1 unidentified aircraft
- 6 run-ups

Reported disturbances (2) that were observed between the hours of 11 PM and 7 AM, at which time the tower is closed and voluntary restrictions are in effect, accounted for 13% of the aircraft disturbance complaints. The volume of complaints received in April 2007 (15 contacts/ 15 complaints) has not significantly changed from April 2006 (14 contacts/ 14 complaints).

APRIL OPERATIONS

LUK operations decreased 6% in April 2007 (5,720 ops.) compared with April 2006 (6,068 ops.). Source of LUK operations information: Lunken Airport Air Traffic Control Tower reports.

LUK IFR operations decreased 3% in April 2007 (4,772 IFR ops.) compared with April 2006 (4,910 IFR ops). In April 2007 IFR ops represented 61% of the total operations vs. 57% in 2006. Source of LUK operations information: Greater Cincinnati-Northern Kentucky International Airport (CVG) Air Traffic Control Tower reports.

AIRSCENE NOISE MONITOR INSTALLATION UPDATE

The monitor #5 site on Airport property is prepped and ready to receive a monitor. Installation of monitors #3 and #5 is pending the availability of Era's acoustical engineer consultant, later in May.

Staff and Era Corporation representatives have identified outstanding flight tracking and noise monitoring system issues to be resolved including data population, staff training, and program upgrades. Staff anticipates that these items will be addressed concurrently with the installation of monitors 3 and 5 and prior to entering into a final maintenance agreement for the noise monitoring system.
