

## **CITY OF CINCINNATI ENVIRONMENTAL CODE CMC 1001 “TITLE X”**

### **Overview**

In 2004, City Council reenacted specific provisions of Cincinnati Municipal Code Title X (“Title X”). The purpose of reenacting Title X was to protect and enhance the quality of the City’s air resources, while promoting the public health, welfare, and comfortable enjoyment of life, property, and recreation of our residences. Title X enables the City to maintain a program for source reduction and prevention, control, and abatement of air pollution consistent with the Federal Clean Air Act and State of Ohio Air Pollution Laws.

The City has partnered with the Hamilton County Department of Environmental Services (“HCDOES”) to enforce Title X. HCDOES is responsible receiving and investigating complaints relating to air quality. After investigating, HCDOES provides the City of Cincinnati Law Department (“Law Department”) with an investigation report. The Law Department evaluates and determines if action is necessary. If action is necessary, the Law Department may issue a civil or criminal citation with fines and other penalties as deemed necessary.

### **What types of Air Quality Complaints have been reported?**

- Odors
- Fugitive Dust
- Smoke
- Particulates
- Open Burning
- Asbestos
