### **Mayor Mallory Announces 1,000 Census Jobs Positions will help complete the 2010 Census**

Cincinnati – Mayor Mark Mallory today announced that the US Census Bureau is seeking to fill 1,000 new jobs to conduct the 2010 Census. The local office of the Census Bureau is currently performing placement testing for new positions at the Census office at 801 Linn Street in the West End. To schedule a testing appointment, interested individuals should call 1-866-861-2010 or 513-766-3040.

“In these troubled economic times, this is an excellent opportunity for 1,000 Cincinnatians to get a good quality job that will give them valuable future job skills and to be part of improving our community,” Mayor Mallory said.

Mayor Mallory has been leading the efforts to prepare for the 2010 Census count of Cincinnati’s population. He has established a Census Complete Count Committee with over 100 members to develop a comprehensive plan to ensure a complete and accurate count.

The Mayor became involved in the Census in 2006 when he successfully challenged the annual Census population estimates recognizing an additional 22,000 residents. Since that challenge, he has become a national leader on improving and modernizing the Census processes in preparation for the 2010 count. Mayor Mallory is chairing the US Conference of Mayors’ 2010 Census Task Force.

The Census is hiring both office staff and field staff. The office positions include Office Clerk, Recruiting Assistant, Administrative Assistant, and Office Operations Supervisor. The field positions include, Enumerator, Crew Leader, Crew Leader Assistant, and Field Operations Supervisor. The pay range for available positions is between \$12 and \$19 per hour. The Census placement test takes approximately 30 minutes.

“The U.S. Census Bureau's Cincinnati office is in the midst of an intense recruitment drive to hire office and field staff from across the Cincinnati area,” George Conner, Cincinnati Census Office Manager said. “The Cincinnati office will hire a staff of over 1,000 temporary employees to conduct the many operations necessary to accurately complete the Cincinnati portion of the 2010 census.”
