AUTHORIZING the City Manager to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with Hamilton County and thirteen other municipal and township jurisdictions agreeing that the City of Cincinnati, Hamilton County, and thirteen other municipal jurisdictions will jointly apply for and accept a grant in the total amount of \$2,992,749 from the Byrne Justice Assistance Grant Program, which grant will be divided among the City of Cincinnati, Hamilton County, and thirteen other municipal and township jurisdictions pursuant to the schedule attached hereto; and further **AUTHORIZING** the City Manager to jointly apply for, accept and appropriate with Hamilton County and thirteen other municipal and township jurisdictions the total amount of \$2,992,749 from the Byrne Justice Assistance Grant Program to be used to fund multiple nonpersonnel expenses and two personnel positions in the Cincinnati Police Department, which positions will be terminated at the end of the grant period unless additional funding becomes available.

WHEREAS, there is available from the Byrne Justice Assistance Grant Program a grant in the amount of \$2,992,749 to be awarded to and divided among the City of Cincinnati, Hamilton County, and thirteen other municipal and township jurisdictions pursuant to the schedule attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, the terms of the grant application require that the City of Cincinnati, Hamilton County, and thirteen other municipal and township jurisdictions apply jointly for the grant and enter into a Memorandum of Understanding specifying that the grant will be divided among the City of Cincinnati, Hamilton County, and thirteen other municipal and township jurisdictions pursuant to the schedule attached hereto; and that the total grant will be paid to the City of Cincinnati and the City of Cincinnati will distribute funds to Hamilton County and thirteen other municipal and township jurisdictions pursuant their respective grant amounts according to the schedule attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, the City of Cincinnati will use the \$1,436,822 it will receive from the grant to fund multiple nonpersonnel expenses and two personnel positions in the Cincinnati Police Department, which positions will be terminated at the end of the grant period unless additional funding becomes available; and

WHEREAS, there are 2 FTEs associated with this grant; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cincinnati, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with Hamilton County and thirteen other municipal and township jurisdictions agreeing that the City of Cincinnati, Hamilton County, and thirteen other municipal and township

jurisdictions will jointly apply for and accept a grant from the Byrne Justice Assistance Grant Program; that the City of Cincinnati, Hamilton County, and thirteen other municipalities are listed on the schedule attached hereto; and that the full amount of the grant from the City of Cincinnati and the City of Cincinnati will pay to Hamilton County and township jurisdictions the amount listed on the schedule attached hereto.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to accept a grant in the total amount of \$2,992,749 from the Byrne Justice Assistance Grant Program for the purpose of funding multiple nonpersonnel expense positions in the Police Department, which positions will be terminated when additional funding becomes available.

Section 3. That the total grant award of \$2,992,749 from the Byrne Justice Assistance Grant Program to the City of Cincinnati, Hamilton County, and thirteen other municipalities is listed on the schedule attached hereto and that the City of Cincinnati and the thirteen other municipal and township jurisdictions the amount of the grant promptly upon receipt of the total grant amount by the City of Cincinnati.

Section 4. That the Director of Finance is authorized to expend the grant therefrom in Fund 501, and that the proper City of Cincinnati funds in compliance with the terms of the grant and the schedule attached hereto.


Section 5. That this ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and

6 of the Charter, be effective immediately. The reason for the emergency is the immediate need to comply with the terms and grant application deadline at the earliest possible time.


