City of Cincinnati Electric Car Incentive Program – Policies and Procedures

On November 26, 2008, City Council passed a motion that modified the City parking regulations to allow all-electric cars displaying a City issued permit to park for free in four specific downtown City-owned parking facilities and at any parking meter that is available at a cost to the public within the City of Cincinnati city limits.

Application Process

Electric Car Incentive Program applications can be obtained online at http://www.cincinnati-oh.gov or in person from the Office of Environment and Sustainability (OES) located inside City Hall, Room 130. Applicants will be contacted via telephone to schedule an appointment for a vehicle inspection. Inperson applications will be accepted by appointment only. City-owned Downtown Parking Facilities included in Electric Car Incentive Program

- Fountain Square South garage 416 Vine Street
- Garfield Garage 13 W. Ninth Street
- Parking Lot at Fifth Street and Race Street
- Seventh Street Garage Level 3 Only

Parking in these facilities is provided on a first come, first serve basis with **no** overnight privileges.

Parking Meters included in the Electric Car Incentive Program

Electric Cars will receive free parking for the time permitted by the parking meter. After the initial time allowed by the meter, the car is required to vacate the spot. Electric cars parking at meters are not exempt from existing parking meter restrictions and are subject to all traffic laws, regulations and enforcement.

Note: The purpose of metered parking is to promote vehicle turnover to support local downtown and Neighborhood Business District businesses.
