CITIZENS POLICE ACADEMY APPLICATION

1. Incomplete applications will NOT be considered.
2. You must be 18 years of age or older to attend the Citizens Police Academy. Individuals under the age of 18 must have approval from the Training Section Commander.
3. A criminal history check will be conducted on each applicant. Applicants with questionable criminal records will be admitted only upon approval of the Training Section Commander.
4. Participants are required to wear appropriate attire and their identification badges (provided at the first session) during all training activities. Identification badges are to be returned to the Training Staff after each session.
5. Participants are required to conduct themselves in a professional manner at all times. Failure to comply may lead to dismissal.
6. Participants are not permitted to carry weapons.
7. Accepted participants will be notified by mail. Class size is limited. Priority will be given to persons living and/or working within the City of Cincinnati. Participation is permitted only for those who have not previously attended this Citizens Police Academy.
