1. PARKING INFRACTION FINES INCREASED, FORM 655P REVISED

City Council has passed two emergency ordinances which increased the fines levied for most parking violations. Most infractions will carry a fine increase of ten dollars (\$10).

The revised Form 655P, Parking Infraction Fine Schedule, is red in color and replaces the gold colored Form 655P. The forms are available for pick-up at Supply Unit for district/section/units to distribute to personnel.

Effective **Sunday, February 01, 2009**, personnel shall begin use of the revised Form 655P. The old forms shall be disposed of through the Department paper recycling bins.

2. CHANGES TO THE HAMILTON COUNTY SPCA HOURS OF OPERATIONS

On December 31, 2008 the Hamilton County SPCA will lose two deputy wardens due to budget cuts. The result of these cut backs will change the availability of deputy wardens to respond to animal complaints. The new hours of operations are as follows:

Deputy Wardens will be on duty six days a week from 7AM to 11PM.

On Holidays, Sundays, and evenings (nights 11PM to 7AM) a deputy warden will be on call through Hamilton County Communications for emergencies only. An emergency would be a stray dog that has inflicted injury and is not controlled or an injured animal needing immediate assistance.

3. COURT HOLIDAY – MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. DAY

National observance of the Martin Luther King, Jr. holiday is Monday, January 19, 2009. The Hamilton County Municipal Court will close ALL courtrooms, except Room "A" in the a.m. Juvenile Court will also be closed.

Police Officers are reminded to not issue citations requiring a court appearance on this date.
