

- The geometry of the ramps connecting I-71 South and SR 562 to each other and to the local road system at Ridge Avenue, Kennedy Road, and Highland is not conducive to smooth traffic flow and safety with the high volumes of traffic that the area is now experiencing.
- The geometry of the interchange also creates a great deal of confusion on the part of visitors, particularly first-time or infrequent visitors to the area.
- These factors affect the ease of access to the newly redeveloping properties and existing commercial and industrial properties in the area.
- This ramp geometry issue is further exacerbated by the intersection of the ramp to southbound 1-71 / westbound Norwood Lateral, which occurs opposite Alamo Avenue at an acute angle.
- Other areas where geometric issues exist include the offset intersections of Ibsen Avenue and Disney Street at Marburg Avenue, and Ibsen Avenue and Camberwell Road at Madison Road.
