Subject: **CCA Case No. 22215 - Review of Discrimination, Discourtesy, and Improper Procedure Allegations by Jessica Jones**

CCA completed an investigation of CCA Complaint No. 22215 by Jessica Jones, F/H/45, alleging Discrimination against Officer Daniel Wuest, #P0458, M/W/33. This memorandum is intended to convey the conclusions resulting from that investigation and the basis for those conclusions. This memorandum does not purport to summarize all evidence uncovered during the course of the investigation, nor is it intended to summarize the entirety of CCA’s file on this matter.

Mrs. Jones alleged that on Thursday, September 15, 2022 at 1:30 PM on 2285 Westwood Northern Boulevard, a police officer later identified by CCA to be Officer Daniel Wuest stopped Mrs. Jones and her husband due to their speed. Mrs. Jones stated that on “Northern Bouvard somewhere coming down the hill and the police officer was there at the intersection, so I suspected it was a race issue. I have never seen an officer parked in that location, ever it’s an all-Black area so I suspected they were just there because the whole area is a Black area.” Mrs. Jones felt that the officer was being disrespectful by getting close to her husband and then blading his stance. Mrs. Jones went on to further allege that the officer did not follow procedure but “not adding any” accommodations related to deafness or deaf persons on the ticket.

CCA interviewed Mrs. and Mr. Jones, Officer Daniel Wuest. CCA also reviewed relevant body worn camera (BWC) recordings, Contact Cards, relevant police records, records from the Hamilton County Clerk of Courts, and computer aided dispatch (CAD) records.

BWC footage contradicted the complainant's version of what occurred. There is no information establishing that Officer Daniel Wuest was disrespectful, failed to properly write the citation or discriminated against Mr. or Mrs. Jones as alleged.


Based on my investigation and review of the evidence uncovered, I recommend the following findings for your endorsement (findings are defined in the attachment to this memorandum):
