



**\*\*\*If you are seeking permission to photograph at Krohn Conservatory, you must call 513-421-5707 and go through Krohn's photo permit process.**

**All other park inquiries, please see information below.**

**-Private photography does not require a fee but DOES require the Park Board to be notified (see below).**

All **commercial** photography/videography in Parks requires an application to be filled out and a permit to be granted. Fees apply to commercial photography/videography. Read all Terms and Conditions on following page.

**"Commercial Photograph/Videography"** means the use of still photography or videography that involves the creation of a product for sale or the advertisement/promotion of a product, service, or organization. If a photo/video shoot requires exclusive use of an area or has extensive set up or props, a Special Use Permit must be obtained, and fees apply. Special Use Permit Applications can be submitted at <https://opencounter.cincinnati-oh.gov/special-events>

**"Private Photography/ Videography"** means the use of photography/videography for personal use. This includes photographers hired for private wedding photos, family photos, and senior pictures (no set up, just camera equipment). If photographers want to use an area for multiple clients, a Commercial Photo Permit and fees apply. Photography/videography used for educational assignments are also considered private. **For private photography/videography, no application or fee is required if no set up is involved; however, the Park Board must be notified to avoid potential conflicts with reservations and events at 513-352-6180.** If extensive set up or exclusive use of an area is required, a Special Use Permit is needed (apply at: <https://opencounter.cincinnati-oh.gov/special-events>)

**Photo permits are issued on a first come, first served basis. The Park Board is under no obligation to issue a photo permit if it is determined that the granting of such permit may reasonably interfere with the use and enjoyment of the Parks.**

**PHOTOGRAPHY RATES:** \$100 flat fee, per park, up to 4 hours.

**VIDEOGRAPHY RATES:** \$200 flat fee, per park, up to 4 hours.

1. All applications require a 2 week notice.

Please complete the Commercial Photo Permit Application on the following page and email to Wesley.Brock@cincinnati-oh.gov. After review, payment can be made over the phone by calling 513-352-6180. We accept Visa or MasterCard.

**2. NO REFUNDS**

3. It should be clearly understood that the Cincinnati Park Board and the City of Cincinnati in no way endorses any product or service connected with the photography/usage.
4. The holder of this permit is liable for " any damage to park land and/or park property. This permit is nontransferable, and must be in your possession on the grounds during shooting/usage.
5. No vehicles are permitted on grass, sidewalks, or other park areas not designated as vehicle parking areas, unless authorized by the Park Board prior to the shoot/usage.
6. Photos or films must not include any park visitors without their prior permission.
7. A permit does not grant exclusive rights to any area within the Cincinnati Parks. All areas must be open to the public. For exclusive use, please call 513-352--6180 for a Special Use Pennit.
8. Photo shoots/usage may not interfere with pedestrian traffic.
9. Photography equipment must be properly placed to prevent trip hazards to the general public.
10. The following park locations are off-limits for photo shoots or videography:

  - Anderson Pavilion at the Waterfront
  - Ault Park Brumm Garden
  - Ault Park Rose Garden
  - Ault Park Pavilion
  - French House
  - Gibson House at Hauck Botanical Gardens
  - Hinkle Gazebo at Eden Park
  - Maple Ridge Lodge at Mt. Airy Forest
  - Mt. Airy Arboretum Braam Gazebo
  - Mt. Airy Arboretum Meyer Lake Gazebo
  - Mt. Airy Arboretum Vasey Garden
  - Mt. Echo Pavilion
  - Oak Ridge Lodge at Mt. Airy Forest
  - Temple of Love at Mt. Storm Park
  - T.M. Berry International Friendship Pavilion
  - Any reserved areas
