

Inwood Park Master Plan Survey Highlights

134 total responses | November 4, 2024 – January 1, 2025

The largest groups of respondents:

- Reside in the zip code surrounding Inwood Park.
- Are between the ages of 25 – 44 years.
- Describe their racial background as white/Caucasian.
- Visit the park monthly, followed by annually, then never, indicating an opportunity to significantly grow park usage.

Inwood Park

What do you love?

- The hillside location, with open greenspace, winding walkways, and old growth trees providing respite from the urban environment for multiple communities.
- The park's historical features like the pavilion and pond and the new recreational amenities such as the PNC playground and picnic shelter.

What would you change?

- Add new amenities like a skatepark, restrooms, water play, picnic areas, fitness equipment, and other suggestions.
- Activate the park with community events and gatherings.
- Use nature as an asset with trees for shade, native landscapes for health and wellness, and invasive species removal.

How should Inwood be used?

The top 3 uses were recreational/wellness, a gathering place for community events, and maintaining/creating natural habitat.

Additional focuses:

Consider the accessibility of Inwood Park, including access to the park and parking options, and how it connects as a whole and to the surrounding communities. A few mentioned other ideas including a dog park, wetland, skatepark, and water features.

History:

Mentioned the unique history of the park features and structures, gymnastics, and fond memories of sledding, dances and swimming.

The Pavilion & the Pond:

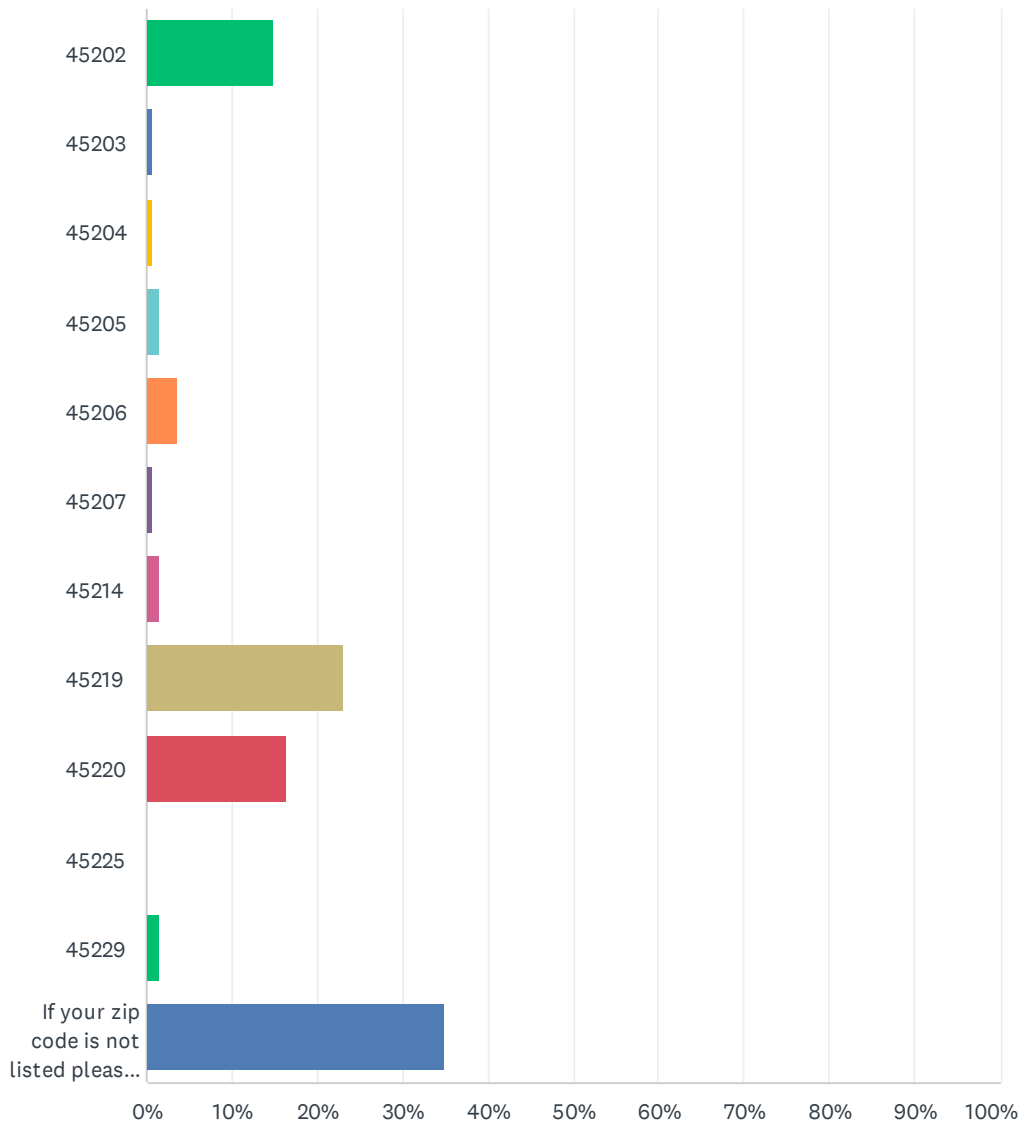
- The top 5 uses in priority order were community events, picnics, private events, wellness activities, and a restroom/comfort station.
- 53% want the pond restored and 47% prefer to remove and repurpose the area.

Safety:

Respondents view safety as a top concern, and they indicated light poles on the pathways, lighting in and around the pavilion and comfort station, security cameras, and removing invasive species as top solutions.

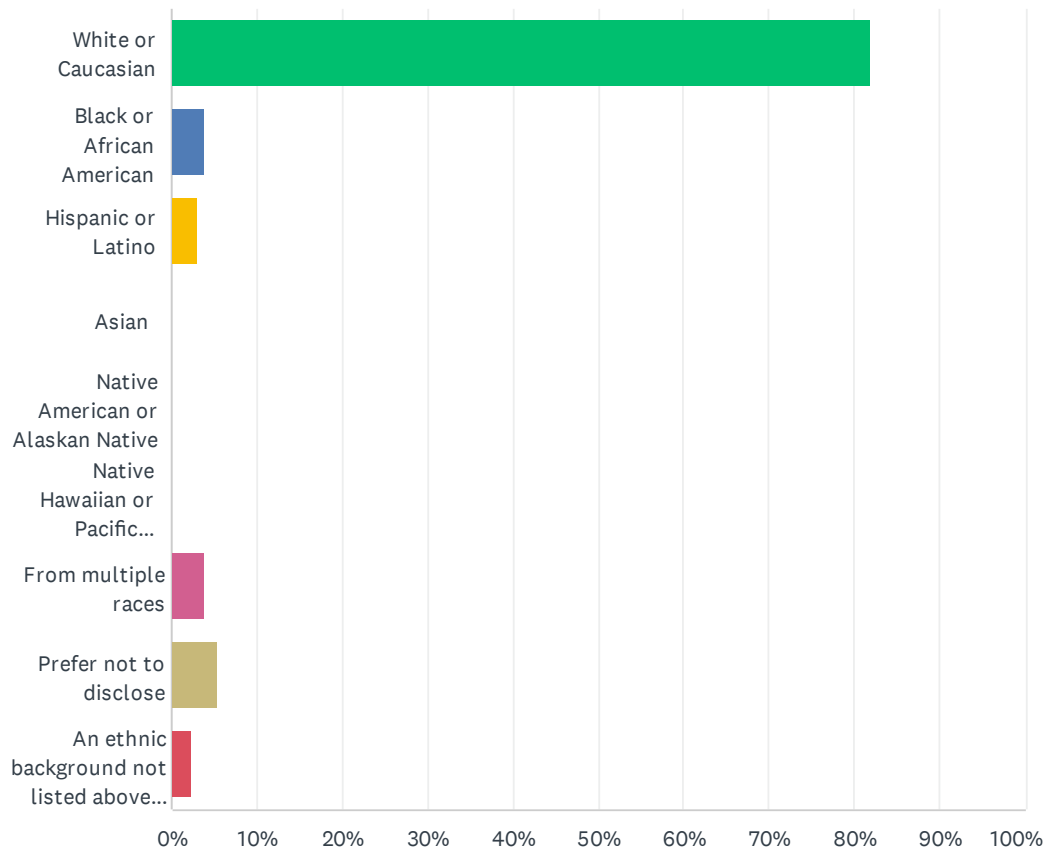

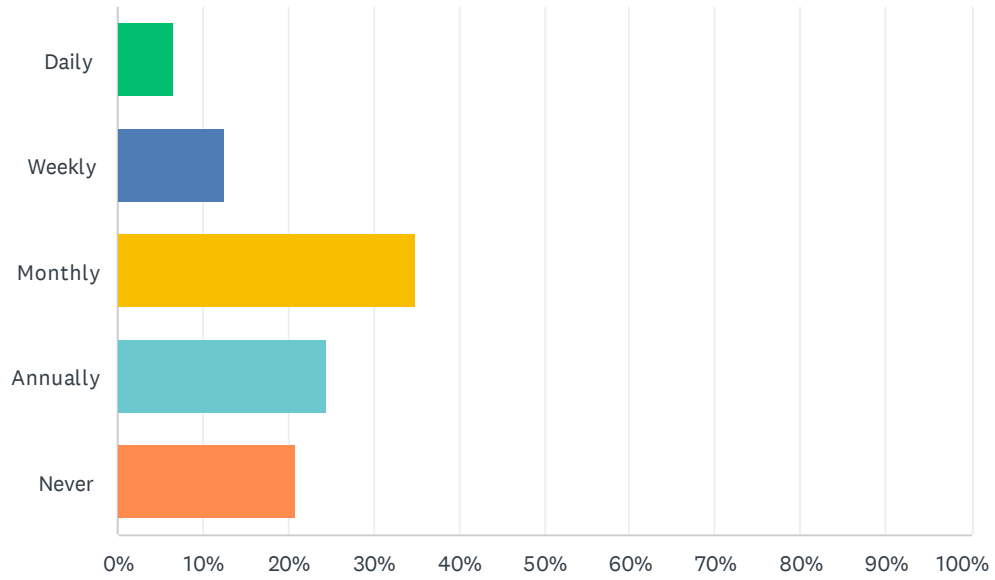

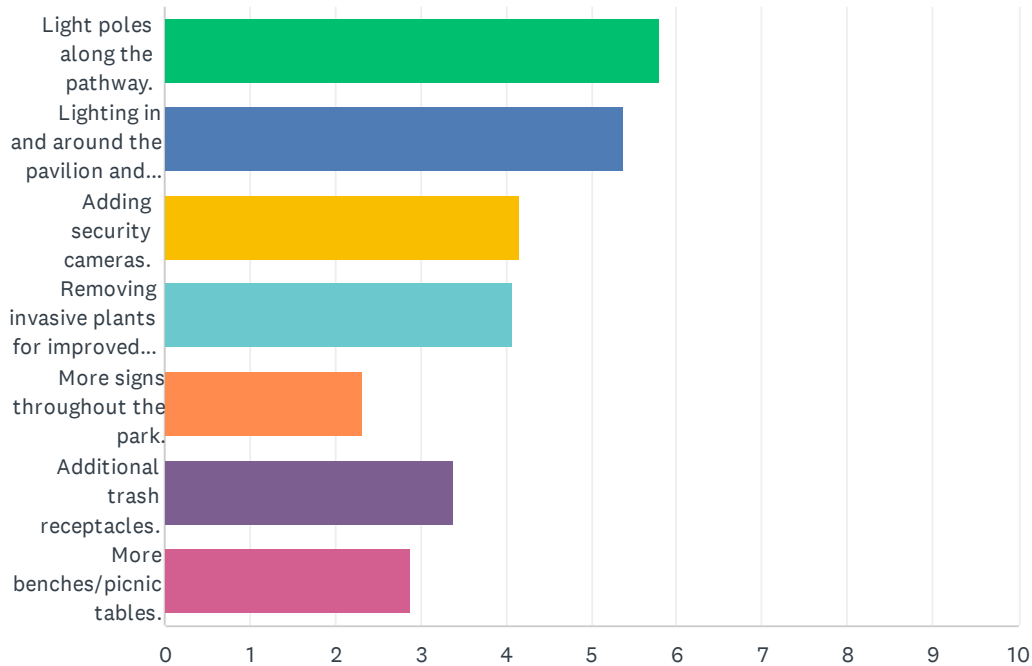

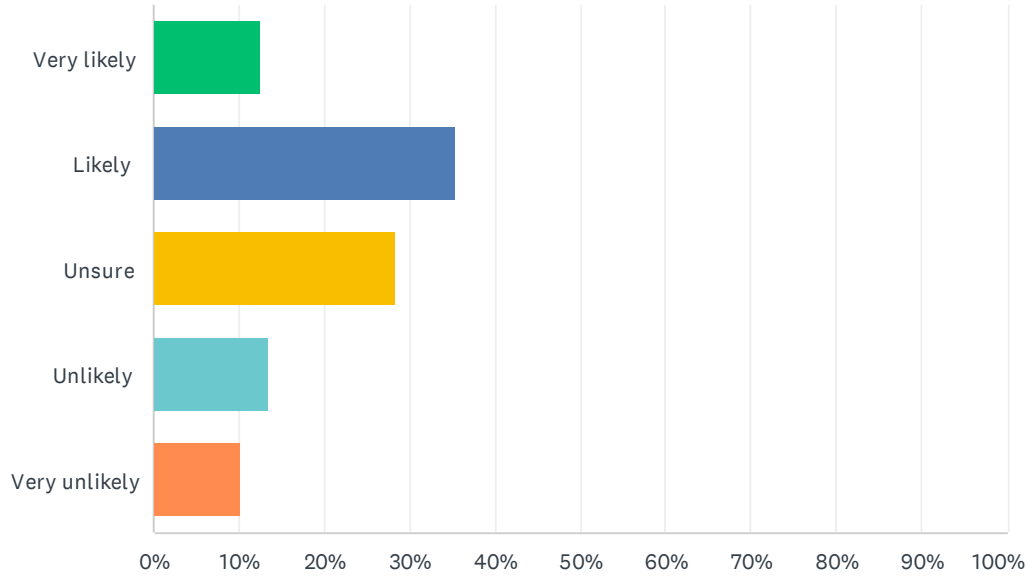

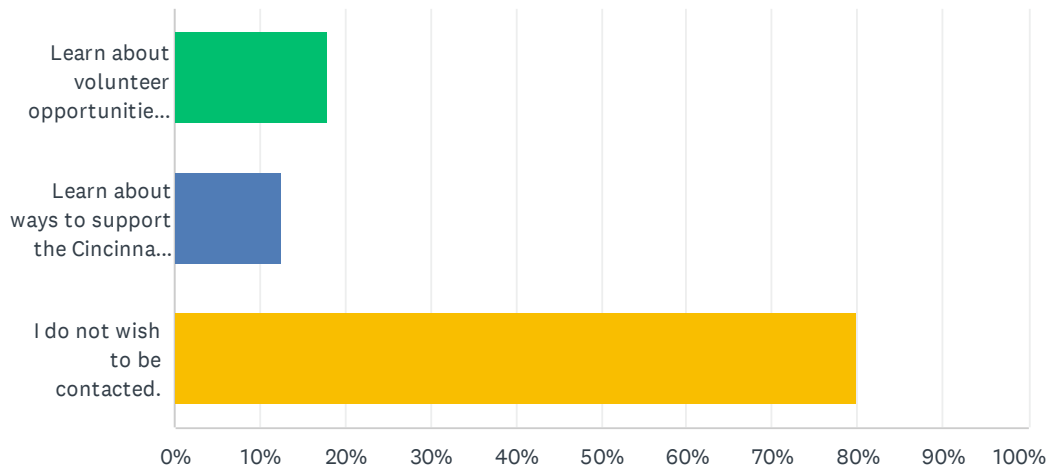
