Why do you love Sawyer Point Park?

- The riverfront, connection to the water, and riverwalk were mentioned many times as well as the overall park setting and diversity of visitors.
- Things to do in the park such as events, music, school field trips, fireworks, and volleyball.
- Playing pickleball and the connections it attracts.

What did you love about the former Sawyer Point Playground?

- Shade and Cover. It was not too hot in the summer and could be used when rainy. People liked it was fenced and kept kids from wondering off.
- It felt Cincinnati themed with a historical connection to the city's past.
- It was large enough for kids to wander and included many things to do, including accessible features, wooden elements, and felt like a fort/castle conducive to imaginative play.

What is your favorite playground and why?

- Inclusivity was discussed frequently. Playgrounds with a good mix of amenities and equipment available to all including offerings for differing abilities and ages.
- Fenced in spaces and blending of natural and non-natural elements were themes.
- Locations that felt safe, well maintained, and had other amenities around such as amphitheaters, restaurants, and recreational activities.
- Uniquely themed spaces with a connection to the community.
- Cincinnati Parks mentioned included Smale, Washington Park, Ziegler, Eden Park at Tom Jones Commons, Pleasant Ridge 1,000 Hands (CRC), and the PNC Grow Up Great Playground in Inwood Park.
- Makino Park in Mason, West Fork Park in Green Township, Summit Park in Blue Ash, and Sharon Woods, are other local parks mentioned frequently.

1. Riverfront & Riverboats
2. Nature & Local Animals
3. Cincinnati Industrial History (flying pigs, soap, riverboats, food)
4. Castles (a feature of the previous playground)
