MOTION, dated 08/07/2017 submitted by Councilmembers Simpson and Young, WE MOVED that the ordinances granting a zone change, property sale, a change in the Planned Development No. 50, and establishment of a new capital improvement project, in favor of Cincinnati's Hospital Medical Center ("CCHMC"), be amended as follows: \* The City will invest the \$583,000 in proceeds from the sale of city right of way, in the Avondale Community Development Corporation. \* CCHMC is required to invest 5% of the development value of its new campus into Avondale over 10 years. Including all investments made in its proposed expansion. This reinvestment will be used on housing development and neighborhood improvements. CCHMC may include the investments made to date in this total. \*CCHMC will commit to meeting a goal of a 10% improvement in measured health outcomes within the Avondale community from the current baseline. \* The City Administration shall perform an assessment, a year after the expansion goes online, of traffic impacts on the community and commit resources to street calming and walkability. \* The City and CCHMC will work together to incent home ownership in Avondale among the current workforce and significant hiring from within the Avondale community. Additionally, they will work together on a plan for permanent jobs, including developing a medical career pathways program for Avondale residents. \* The community engagement committee started by CCHMC meet on an ongoing and periodic bases, i.e. monthly or bi-monthly, with the Avondale community to discuss any unexpected negative consequences from the planned expansion.
