This introduction of ShotSpotter into the Avondale neighborhood has helped produce impressive results for reductions in shootings. The Cincinnati Police Department's (CPD) data indicates that at one point, more than 80 percent of gunfire was not being reported to CPD, but that after the introduction of ShotSpotter, gunfire in Avondale was down over 40 percent in 2018 compared to 2017. collective bargaining agreements, the city manager shall be authorized to take all necessary action to provide non-represented City employees with an Election Day holiday, substituting such newly recognized holiday for Presidents' day which would thereafter cease to be a recognized holiday for such employees, following the City Manager's consultation with non-represented employees to obtain relevant input from such City employees regarding modification of the holiday schedule; and further AUTHORIZING the City Manager to develop administrative regulations to provide that, prior to the implementation of Election Day as a holiday for all City employees, a City employee shall be permitted to leave his or her place of City employment for a reasonable amount of time or to arrive at work at a reasonably later time or leave work reasonably early in order to vote at the employee's designated polling place on Election Day in the City of Cincinnati, the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November, without being charged for such time from the employee's vacation leave balance.
