STATEMENT, (EMERGENCY ORDER) (Public Participation Protocols) submitted by Mayor John Cranley, Pursuant to Article III of the Cincinnati Charter, Article XVIII of the Administrative Code of the City of Cincinnati, recent orders from the Ohio Department of Health, and in anticipation of large crowds at City Hall during the finale weeks before summer recess, it is hereby ordered that the City Administration shall establish and enforce protocols protective of the

public health during the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic for public participation and comment during any City Council or Council committee meeting. The reason for the protocols is the need to allow reasonable forum for citizens' comments while ensuring the safety and health of all participants and City staff at such meetings. Such protocols shall establish that social distancing requirements will be enforced in Council Chambers and any other impacted spaces within City Hall and that any person offering public comments shall be required to exit City Hall after speaking in chambers for so long as there are individuals queued to offer public comment in order to safely accommodate members of the public. The aim of this order is to ensure that all persons seeking to speak in-person at Council Chambers have an opportunity to do so. The public comment protocols shall provide appropriate space for members of the media as well as any other health or safety protocols determined by the City Administration to be necessary. In order to safely accommodate public participation, the Clerk of Council shall also provided opportunities for remote participation and comment. The Clerk of Council shall work with the City Administration to ensure all protocols are enforced. This order has the force of law and is an emergency measure issued pursuant to Article III of the Cincinnati Charter, Article XVIII of the Administrative Code of the City of Cincinnati and recent orders from the Ohio Department of Health. This Order is based upon the existence of a condition of public danger or emergency, as established by the Mayor's Declaration of Emergency in relation to the COVID-19 pandemic and shall continue in effect in accordance with its term.

STATEMENT, (DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY) submitted by Mayor John Cranley, The ongoing COVID-19 pandemic presents emergency conditions and dangers to the public health and welfare without precedent in the past 100 years. After declaring a state of emergency and instituting severe measures to "flatten the curve," the State of Ohio has begun to reopen Ohio's economy, sector by sector, concluding that initial steps toward reopening can be safely taken in accordance with good hygiene and social distancing measures. Consistent wit the State's reopening efforts and at the request of the City Manager, I hereby amend, revise and tailor the existing COVID-19 declaration of emergency to this new phase of the response to the pandemic, pursuant to Article III of the Cincinnati Charter and Article XVIII of the Administrative Code of the City of Cincinnati. The emergency condition and danger that forms the basis for this amended and revised declaration is the ongoing public health emergency caused by the pandemic and the need to enable the safe reopening of the City including, but not limited to, reopening of retail businesses, restaurants and workplaces in the City. By this revised declaration, the Mayor retains emergency authority to issue orders under the limited circumstances necessary for the safe reopening of Cincinnati. This declaration is consistent with the statewide health emergency declared by Governor DeWine, the issuance of Ohio Department of Health's compulsory health orders and related guidelines and the fundamental need to protect vulnerable populations during this pandemic. This Order supersedes the March 11, 2020, emergency declaration as to any conflicts and hereby amends any such conflicts consistent with the provisions of this declaration. All emergency orders issued under the March 11, 2020, declaration are hereby terminated except for the Outdoor Street Dining and Social Distancing order dated May 12, 2020, a copy of which is attached to this declaration, which is extended. If extended, emergency orders shall continue in effect in accordance with the terms of Article XVIII of the Administrative Code. This amended and revised declaration shall be issued to the news media

for the widest possible dissemination to the citizens of Cincinnati. This declaration shall be effective June 29, 2020.

MOTION, dated 06/22/2020, submitted by Councilmembers Sittenfeld, Young, Kearney, Seelbach and Landsman; WE MOVE that the increase to the Cincinnati Police Department's existing Fiscal Year 2020 Budget in the City Manager and Mayor's Fiscal Year 2021 Budget be redirected to youth employment and opportunities. WE FURTHER MOVE that this can be achieved by modestly adjusting the projected attrition for Fiscal Year 2021, and by a 1.5 - month delay in the next recruit class. MOTION, submitted by Councilmembers Sittenfeld, Seelbach, Young, Kearney and Landsman, Smart public policy certainly can't cure every evil or erase the hate in some people's hearts. But it can still do transformative good and we remain hungry, as does our community for new ideas. Here are policies and ideas that we either already support and will sponsor; policies where we need your help and advocacy; and policies which at minimum deserve consideration and review by our City Council in collaboration with the City Law Department: - Strengthening and funding the next phase of our city's Collaborative Agreement - Immediately reconvening the Manager's Advisory Group, the body responsible for providing guidance on policing - to allow for increased community involvement and civilian oversight - Fully funding the Citizen Complaint Authority - Passing an ordinance punishing 'knowingly or recklessly' reporting someone to the police on the sole basis of their race, gender or other bias - Expansion of our Bail Reform policy; Cincinnati City Council has instituted its first-ever bail reform legislation and we believe we should now expand it, ending the system of wealth-based detention. Furthermore, public pressure must be put on Hamilton County, which contains the Prosecutor's office, to do the same as that is where the majority of defendants are processed - Advocacy on next steps for divestment from the private prison industry. Cincinnati City Council has sponsored a divestment policy from private prisons. However, the Cincinnati Retirement System Board has not yet carried out our directive and they must be pressured to do so - Given current Constitutional prohibitions against residency requirements for Police Officers, finding creative ways to facilitate more officers living in the community that they police. The policy of awarding additional points to police applicants who come through our city's Public School safety academy is a good example of this - Similarly, we need to find legally allowable mechanisms to help the composition of our Police Department better reflect the demographics of our City (currently, Cincinnati is ~ 44% black, with a Police Department that is ~ 29% black) -Legislation making it illegal for the Police Department to hire officers who were previously fired or who resigned while being investigated for serious misconduct and/or excessive force - Legislation making it subject to a vote of the City Council for the Police Department to receive military weapons or equipment. MOTION, submitted by Councilmember Landsman, WE MOVE that the City Administration review the recommended neighborhood parking proposal as presented by CUF community leaders in May of 2020 and provide a plan to fully fund and implement the following recommendations by December of 2020: Encourage

better utilization of existing off-street parking in the Calhoun/McMillan Business District: - Public garages: expand availability of monthly passes, provide better signage and wayfinding, evaluate pricing and adjust accordingly, and assist with marketing garages to the groups that previously used on-street unmetered parking such as UC commuters and employees of businesses. Discourage free long-term parking in the currently unmetered on-street spaces in the residential areas to the south and west of UC: - Provide signage and enforcement for street sweeping, therefore requiring cars to be moved at least monthly or else they are progressively warned, then ticketed, then ultimately towed should they not comply. Work with UC to promote medium term parking (ex: satellite lots) in less congested areas to move commuter cars off of residential streets. Promote and fund non-single occupancy vehicle transportation options to UC students and faculty, and provide easier options for long, medium and short distance commuters: - Encourage and assist in providing infrastructure for bikes, scooters, and ride share programs such as Uber and Lyft. - Assist in advancing an Uptown circulator shuttle in cooperation with SORTA and UC. - Create One Way Streets with Bike Lanes: Flora, Victor, Stratford, Chickasaw, Rohs, Wheeler, Moerlein, & Ohio. WE MOVE that after these changes above have fully implemented (December of 2020), the City Administration, working alongside neighborhood leaders, will then assess the need for a residential parking permit program. Assuming there is still a need for greater intervention, the neighborhood leaders and City Administration will then provide a plan to fully fund and implement a residential parking permit program unique to the CUF community by June of 2021 (end of FY21).
