ORDINANCE, (EMERGENCY) submitted by Mayor John Cranley, ESTABLISHING the salary and appropriate level of benefits of Paula Boggs Muething as Interim City Manager while she serves in that position.

ORDINANCE (EMERGENCY), dated 6/22/2020, submitted by Patrick A.
