I. Operations Report

- Highest traffic in over 15 years. Corporate travel up and student training significantly up as well. All contribute to fuel revenue. Price of fuel is up but we receive income on gallons of fuel.

II. Financial Report

- Fuel volume is way up.
- Landing fee information is not accurate which undercounts. A new contractor will be cheaper and more accurate. ADSB tracking device required for all planes so tracking should be easier going forward.

III. Hotel Development Update

- No update but City will reach out to Guy about an update as well as participate in the April 10 Board meeting. City Economic Development is lead agency on the project.

IV. Approval of Minutes – The minutes from the December 12, 2022 minutes were approved unanimously.

V. Miscellaneous
