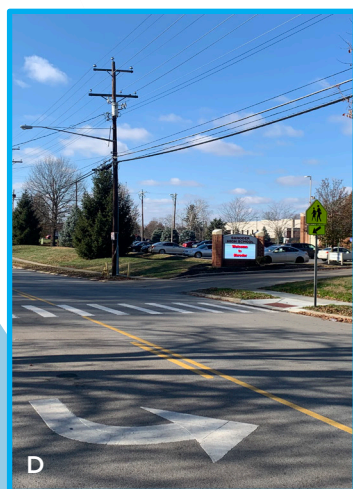


COMPLETE STREETS 2023

The Department of Transportation and Engineering is committed to building a transportation network that enables people of all ages and abilities to safely and comfortably move around the city using all modes of travel. The following Complete Street features were completed in 2023.

- 4 miles of new bike facilities
- 169,621 square feet of new/repaired/widened sidewalk and 169 curb ramp installations
- 112 traffic-calming improvements
- 557 safety improvements
- 515 comfort enhancements
