Sec. 861-1. - Skating Rink Defined.

"Skating rink" shall mean an outdoor or indoor rink where ice or roller skating is permitted for a fee or other compensation.

Sec. 861-3. - License Required.

No person, firm or corporation shall operate a skating rink or permit a skating rink in their possession or contract to be so operated, unless they have been duly licensed to operate such skating rink and have paid the license fee as provided in Section 861-9, herein.

Sec. 861-5. - Application for License.

Application for a license to operate a skating rink shall be made upon forms provided by the director of safety which shall set forth the name and address of the applicant, the location of the skating rink, the dimensions of the area used for skating purposes, the nature of the skating rink and such other information as shall be required by the director of safety.

Sec. 861-7. - Issuance of License.

If the director of safety finds that the location of the rink is permissible under the zoning laws and complies with all requirements of public safety and is supplied with sufficient toilet facilities, the director of safety shall grant the application and notify the city treasurer who shall issue the license upon the payment of the proper license fee.

Sec. 861-9. - License Fees.

Licenses for skating rinks shall be issued annually upon payment of the fees in accordance with the following schedule:

Per 1,000 square feet for each rink up to 5,000 square feet in skating area, \$125.00;

Per 1,000 square feet for the next 5,000 square feet in skating area per rink, \$75.00;

For each additional 1,000 square feet in excess of 10,000 square feet in skating area per rink, \$45.00.

Sec. 861-11. - Hours of Operation.

Skating rinks shall be operated only between the hours of 8 a.m. and 2:30 a.m.

Sec. 861-13. - Revocation.

The director of safety shall have power to revoke the license granted to operate a skating rink for violation of any of the provisions of this chapter or if, in the director's opinion, any skating rink is being operated in a manner detrimental to the public health, safety and welfare.

Sec. 861-99. - Penalties.

Whoever violates any provision of Section 861-3 of this chapter shall be fined not more than \$50. Each day's operation of a skating rink without a license shall constitute a separate offense.
