

# SHORT-TERM RENTAL ADVISORY

## EXIT PLAN

### GUEST RESPONSIBILITIES

Per the Cincinnati Municipal Code, you are required to:

- CH 1117 - not overcrowd the dwelling, exceeding maximum occupancy
- TITLE XIV & XVII – illegal zoning use such as a hotel, rooming house or use for parties and assembly
- CH 909 - keep noise below maximum decibel levels; typically 55 decibel over continuous period from 7 pm to 7 am
- TITLE XVI - maintain the property in good condition, particularly managing trash, and parking cars on paved surfaces

### OPERATOR RESPONSIBILITIES

Per the Cincinnati Municipal Code, they are required to

- TITLE XI - maintain a safe and sanitary dwelling
- TITLE XII - maintain fire safety concerns, such as clear exit paths, smoke alarms, etc.
- TITLE XVI - maintain the property in good condition, particularly managing trash, and parking cars on paved surfaces
