

## City of Cincinnati Electric Car Incentive Program – Policies and Procedures

Note: The City of Cincinnati will sunset the Electric Vehicle (“EV”) Incentive Program effective July 1, 2024. Permits will be valid through 6/30/24. Beginning 7/1/24, permits will expire and no longer be honored. Vehicles will be subject to regular street parking fees and ticketing policies.

On November 26, 2008, Cincinnati City Council passed a motion that modified the City parking regulations to allow all-electric cars displaying a City issued permit to park for free at any City-owned parking meter or City-owned street parking kiosk that is available within the City of Cincinnati city limits. Cincinnati city meters say ‘City of Cincinnati’ on the meter. If it says another city, the permit does not apply, and parking is not free.

**The permit sticker must be placed on the passenger side, on the front windshield, just above the dashboard in the far-right corner.**

### Parking Meters & Single Pay Street Parking Kiosks included in the Electric Car Incentive Program

Electric Cars with permits will receive free parking for the maximum time permitted as displayed by the parking meter or kiosk. After the initial time allowed by the meter or kiosk, the car is required to vacate the spot. Permitted electric cars parking at meters are not exempt from existing parking meter restrictions and are subject to all traffic laws, regulations, and enforcement. If you should receive a parking ticket for non-payment of meter (ONLY), please contact City of Cincinnati Parking at 513-352-4527, option 9 to resolve it.

**Surface Parking Lots and garages are not eligible.**

**This EV permit does not serve as a "residential parking permit" in those types of restricted areas. Please read all signage carefully to determine eligibility to park in any residential permitted parking area.**
