Request for Qualifications (RFQ) Respondents,

The City of Cincinnati ("City") would like to thank you for responding to RFQ858GCWWPRVLEAD for Lead Service Line Replacement services for the City.

The Greater Cincinnati Water Works Department received eight responses to the RFQ and the respondents were reviewed based on criteria in eight areas. The criteria included:

1. Described expertise and experience in the use trenchless technology methods to install water service lines, such as the "cable" or "boring" method.
2. Described expertise and experience in open-cut trench installation methods for water service line installations.
3. List of equipment owned or rented that will be used to complete the work.
4. List of similar water service line installations or replacements performed in the last 3 years.
5. List of any employee(s) who is a licensed plumber with the State of Ohio or another state plumbing licensing board.
6. List number of employees on staff to perform the work described in the RFQ.
7. Proof of liability insurance and workers compensation insurance with the State of Ohio.
8. Indicate performance and payment bonding capability amounts.

Pursuant to a process of evaluating the proposals by the City, the following firms have been selected to the pool of pre-qualified vendors.

The City reserves the right to periodically review performance of each vendor and remove firms from the pool.

Placement on the pre-qualified vendors' list ("the List") for the aforementioned services does not

guarantee that the company will receive any work from the City, nor does it imply that the company has any type of procurement relationship with the City either now or in the future. Quotes or proposals will be solicited from vendors on the List.

The List is effective starting on the date of this letter and expires December 31, 2022, with two optional renewal periods of 1 year each, for a final expiration date of December 31, 2024. Upon or around the expiration date of the List, the City may issue a new Request for Qualifications to refresh the list.
