The City of Cincinnati's "Cincinnati Recycles" is looking for canvassers to increase recycling rates in Roselawn through education and resident recycling support. Canvassers also will be collecting data concerning challenges and barriers to residents' recycling efforts.

BACKGROUND:

Residential recycling creates jobs, reduces long-term costs to the community, prevents usable materials from being dumped into a landfill, reduces our environmental impact and helps preserve our natural resources. Thus, the more our local communities recycle the stronger the positive impact on our communities! Our goal is to educate the public about the positive benefits of recycling and to simultaneously address individual residents' barriers, concerns and challenges to recycling.

QUALIFICATIONS AND COMPENSATION:

Candidate must be available during peak canvassing times, 4:30p.m. - 8 p.m. Monday – Wednesday, Saturday 10:30a.m. – 3p.m. and Sunday 12:30p.m. – 5p.m. Candidate must have their own transportation and would ideally be from or familiar with the Roselawn area. Candidate must have interests in recycling, conservation and/or bettering their community with strong communication and active listening skills. Applicants must be physically able to climb stairs and walk for the duration of the shift. They also must be organized and able to record accurate and detailed information while talking with residents in the field. This project is temporary; training and canvassing will take place for 4-6 weeks, primarily in September and October. Compensation is \$9-\$13.00 per hour.
