

New Police Radio Operator Appointed Veteran Municipal Employee to Retire

The appointment of a new radio operator for Station X and the retirement of a veteran Municipal Court clerk, were announced Wednesday at City Hall.

Chester Spearing, Delta avenue, former radio operator with the State Highway Patrol at Wilmington and Columbus, will take over a similar position with the police radio here. He fills the vacancy created when Julian W. Bronson, chief radiotrician, and a Naval Reserve member, recently was

called for active duty. James Hearn will become acting chief radiotrician.

Julius "Cy" Young, 65, who has held various public positions since 1914, will retire Sept. 30, he informed Elmer F. Hunsicker, clerk of courts. For the last six years Mr. Young has been a deputy in the Municipal Court clerk's office.

He started 27 years ago with the civil division of the office and also
