

# Answer to 911 call may be a new law

Representatives of the Greater Cincinnati Chamber of Commerce and the Cincinnati Academy of Medicine met recently in Columbus with the executive board of the County Commissioners Association of Ohio to discuss the "Enhanced 911" system proposed for Hamilton, Butler and Clermont counties in Southwestern Ohio.

E911 is the answering system

for police, fire and emergency medical services developed by Bell Labs in 1978. The system allows citizens to call a single central number for various types of emergency aid.

The County Commissioners Association agreed to assist in the preparation of enabling legislation that is necessary at the state level in order to ask for a citizen referendum on E911
