3. Discussion of Revised 2025 Post-Election Campaign Finance Reports (Motions Required)

Ian opened the discussion, explaining that this portion will present two candidates that had issues identified on their filings. There is only one issue to consider and that is “Does the revised filing address the issues identified in the prior review?”

Ian began with a Review of Revised 2025 Post-Election Campaign Filings of Jeff Cramerding. There was one overcontribution of \$1,100 by one individual.
