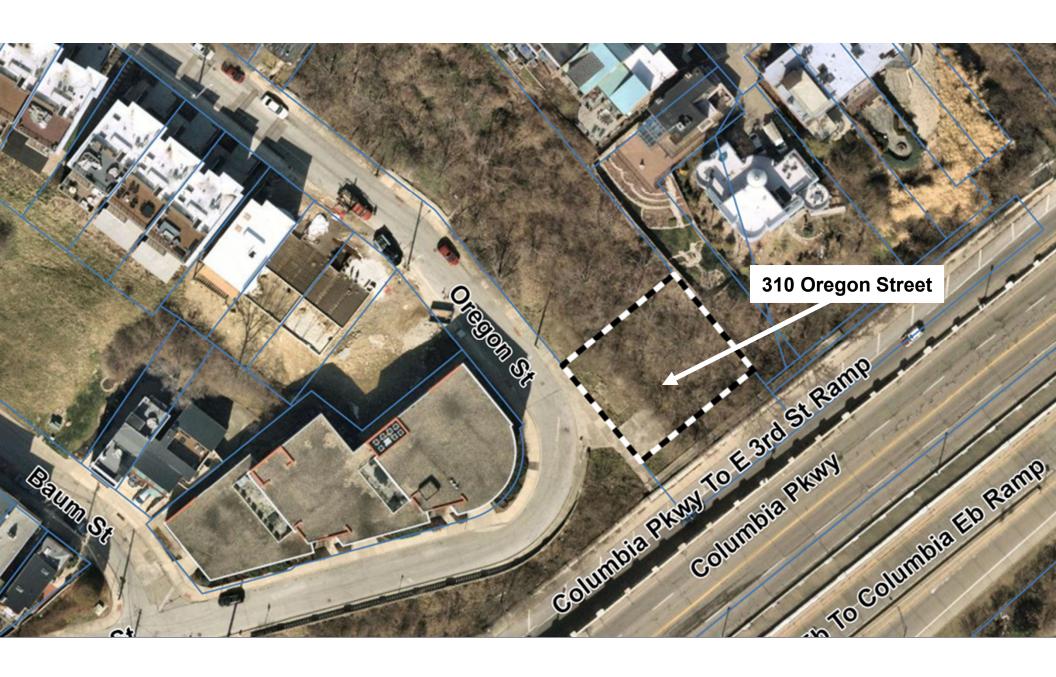

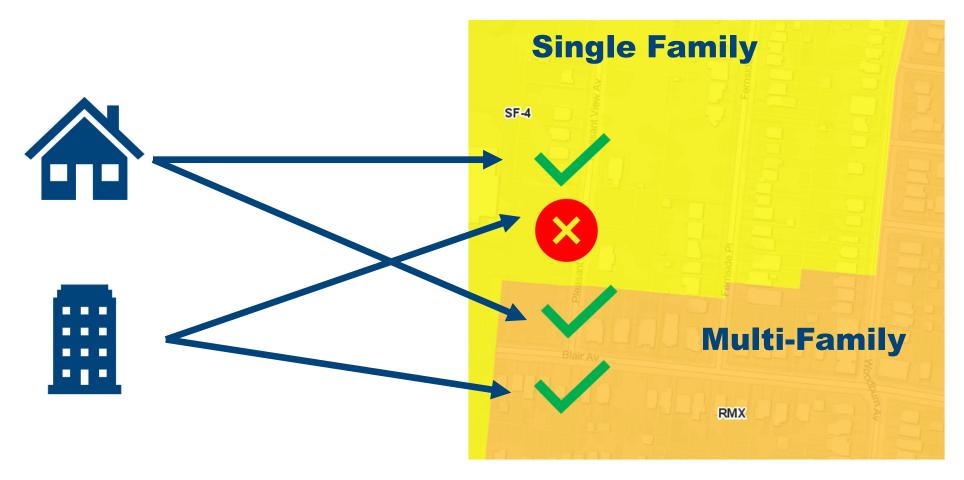


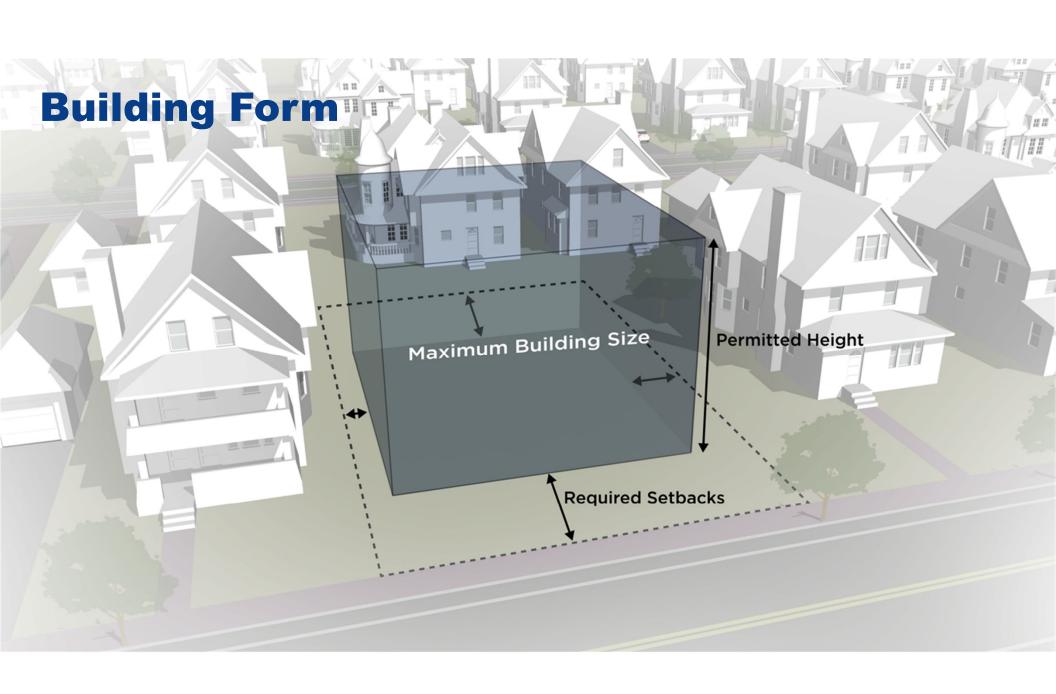


Zoning regulates two things:

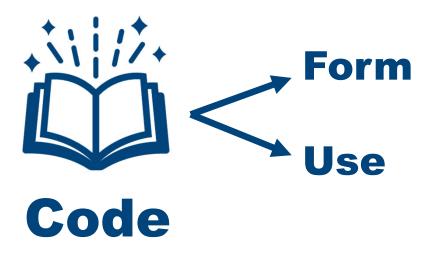
- 1. What you can build → Use

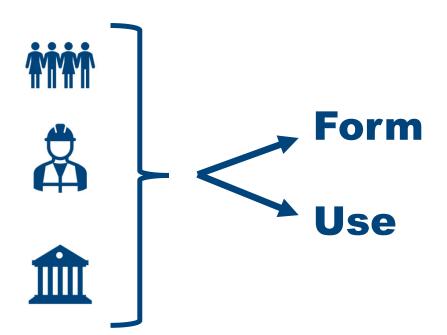




Typical Zoning

What is a Planned Development?

A zoning district that allows for **greater flexibility** in design but comes with **additional oversight** and approvals

What is a Final Development Plan?

A detailed plan approved by the City Planning Commission that the developer of the PD must abide by

Stage 1



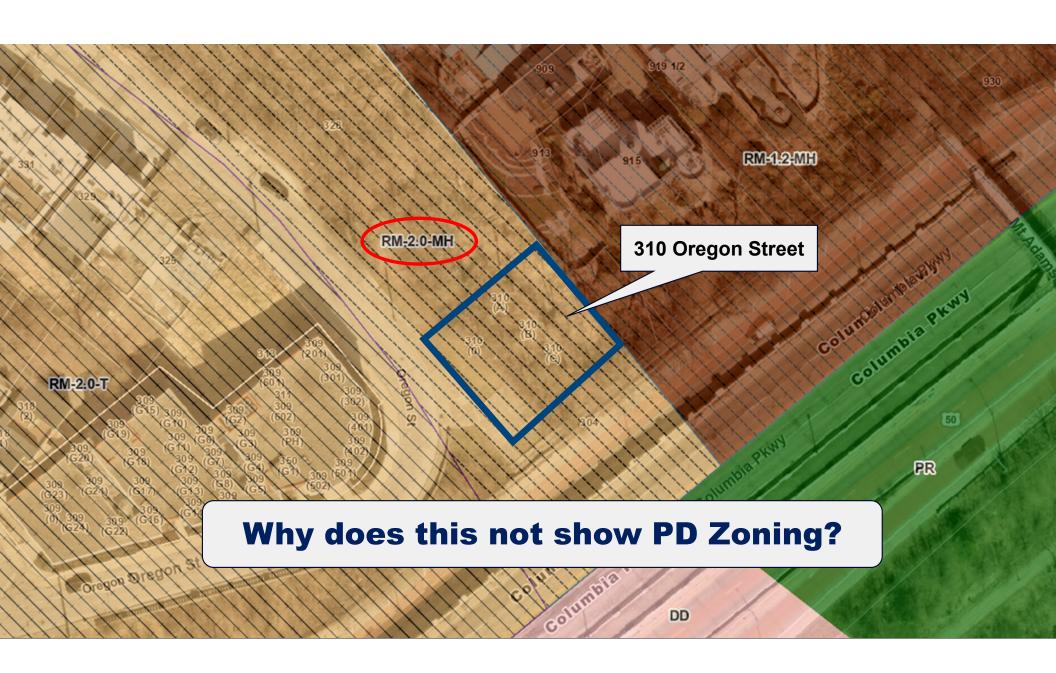

➤ Design, signage, detailed plans



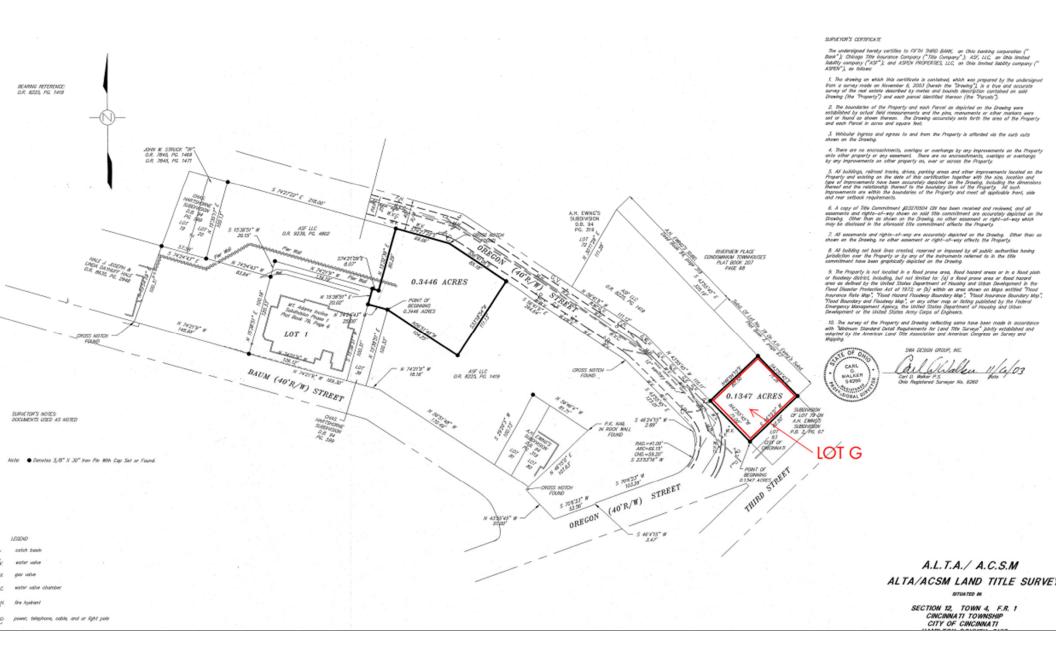
PD timeline

2002 – Applied for PUD under old Zoning Code, construction starts

2004 - Cincinnati Zoning Code updated, PD not reflected on map

2012 – Determined that the owner has vested rights under the old PUD, now considered a PD

2025 – Applicant applies for current proposal

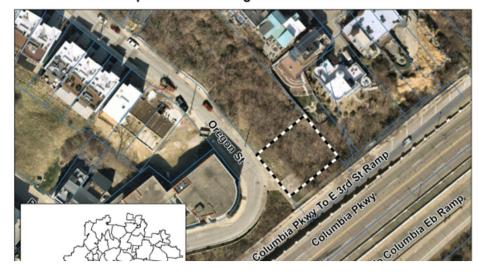

Proposed Final Development Plan at 310 Oregon Street in Mt. Adams Background

The applicant, Tilsley and Associates, is requesting a Final Development Plan (FDP) for Lot G of the Oregon Street and Baum Street Planned Development (PD) at 310 Oregon Street in Mt. Adams. The subject property is currently vacant, and the applicant is proposing to build a three-unit condominium building with parking located in a first-floor garage. The Oregon Street and Baum Street PD has legacy "Planned Unit Development" (PUD) zoning rights that were determined by the City before the Zoning Code was updated in 2004.

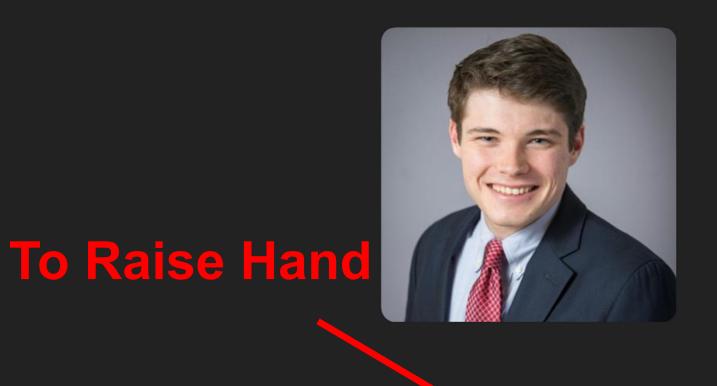
